

"And spice, and Oil For The Light, and for the anointing oil, and for the sweet incense." *Exodus 35:28 KJV*

With no oil, wicks quickly burn to ash. The oil burns brightly hour after hour, because the wick is the light's conduit. However, if the wick is the only fuel, it quickly burns out and the darkness quickly fills with a foul stench. Believers are the "Light," singular, of Truth in sin's darkness, because the "Oil" is the same for each. "Ye are the Light of the world. The Anointing Which ye have received of Him Abideth In you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as The Same Anointing Teacheth you of all things, and Is Truth." Believer's words and deeds are conduits of Truth's Light to those seeking their way out of sin, but deeds must accompany words. "Faith without Works is dead" If believers are not obedient by Faith, there will be no "Light" in the darkness; only the stench of human effort. "Let your Light So Shine before men, that they may see your GOOD WORKS, and glorify your Father." Obedience Through Faith in God's Word is the "Light" of Truth. Ever notice when it's really dark, a tiny speck of light is seen immediately? True believers stand out. Light seeks the seeker. "For the Son of man Is Come To Seek And To Save that which was lost. The Hour Cometh, And Now Is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in Truth: for the Father Seeketh such to worship Him." Evil does try to extinguish "Light," because "men loved darkness." The Tabernacle Candlestick had seven flames, but one oil. Seven is the Scriptural number of singular completion. Men may snuff individual wicks, but never the Light of Truth. "Forever, O Lord, Thy Word Is Settled In Heaven. When they deliver you up, take no thought how or what ye shall speak: for It Shall Be Given you in that same hour what ye shall speak. For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father Which Speaketh In you. Even the Spirit of Truth; Whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him: but ye know Him; for He dwelleth With you, and Shall Be In you. Know ye not that ye are the Temple of God, and that the Spirit of God Dwelleth In you? For It Is God Which Worketh In you Both To Will And To Do of His Good Pleasure. Even the Mystery Which Hath Been Hid from ages and from generations, but now Is Made Manifest To His Saints: To Whom God Would Make Known What Is the Riches of the Glory of This Mystery among the Gentiles; Which Is Christ In you, The Hope of Glory." Our Light's "Oil" is the unseen Holy Spirit, Guiding "into all Truth" Through Faith. "Faith Cometh by hearing...the Word of God."

The tiny glow of a candle is easily seen by aircraft thousands of feet in the air. When you begin to think of your Light as insignificant, remember: your Light Is God's Word and It Is Always Significant.
