Why does God Delight in a man? I immediately think of Enoch who “walked with God and was not, for God Took him;” of Abraham who was “the Friend of God;” of faithful Joseph who remained true to God in the face of life-threatening circumstances; of Moses who communed with God “face to Face;” of David a man “after God’s Own Heart;” of the virgin Mary, “Favoured among women;” of Mary Magdalene, met in the garden by the Newly Risen Saviour before He Ascended to the Father; of Paul, favored with a Personal Encounter on the road to Damascus. There are many others. These were no more or less human than you or I; no more righteous or less prone to sin. What endeared them to God? Let’s examine the scriptures. “The steps of a good man are Ordered by the LORD: and he delighteth in His Way. – The LORD Taketh Pleasure in them that fear Him, in those that Hope in His Mercy. – The LORD Taketh Pleasure in His People: He Will Beautify the meek with Salvation. – I know also, my God, that Thou Triest the heart, and Hast Pleasure in uprightness. – For Thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with Thee. The foolish shall not stand in Thy Sight: Thou Hatest all workers of iniquity. – The just shall Live By Faith: but if any man draw back, My Soul Shall Have no pleasure in him. – If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My Face, and turn from their wicked ways; then Will I Hear From Heaven, And Will Forgive their sin, and Will Heal their land. – For thus Saith the High and Lofty One that Inhabiteth Eternity, Whose Name Is Holy; ‘I Dwell In The High And Holy Place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to Revive the spirit of the humble, and to Revive the heart of the contrite ones.’ – God Resisteth the proud, but Giveth Grace unto the humble. – By Faith Enoch Was Translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God Had Translated him: for before his Translation he had this testimony, that he Pleased God. But without Faith It Is Impossible To Please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He Is, And That He Is A Rewarder of them that diligently seek Him.” It’s very plain: If you run from God you will know only His Wrath. The True believer knows and fears His Power, is grateful for His Love And Grace, and gleefully anticipates His Return!
