God is a plural singularity. While it is absolute Truth, to human thinking, it is a bit abstract, because man is restricted to the five physical senses. The butterfly's three stages of life give a visual construct of what happens when faith converts a man. Debate it all you want, but there is no ambiguity to the plain Truth of 1 John 5:7: *"For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one."* I reiterate; God is a plural singularity! It may help to better understand it if put in context with Genesis 1: *"God created man in his own image."* By extrapolation man is a plural singularity. Man is body, soul, and spirit. Your body drives a car, your mind ponders a distant vacation, and your spirit anticipates. Your soul is on vacation, your body drives, and your spirit sings. This is a crude illustration, at best, because man is not omnipresent. God is everywhere at once; omnipresent. *"If I make my bed in hell, behold, Thou art there."* He knows everything; past, future, thought, and intent at once; omniscient. He possesses all power, universe, government, judgment, punishment, reward; omnipotent. His attributes and character are all at once perfect and infinite! Argue what God recorded in His Written Word and you've chosen the consequence. God is His Word, the Word is Christ, and Christ is God! (John 1:1) Upon a repentant call for God's mercy, man's spirit, separated from God by sin, is once again joined with God, the Holy Spirit. Thus quickened, by virtue of God's very presence, a believer's spirit is sealed for eternity by God Himself! *"Beloved, now are we the sons of God, but it doth not yet appear what we shall be."* Our soul is a *"living soul"* by virtue of the presence of a living God, but our body awaits redemption on Jesus Christ's return. *"We ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. Behold, I shew you a mystery; we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord."* So, will you go with Him when He comes, or be left behind?

The body is the reason for our troubles on earth, because *"in my flesh, dwelleth no good thing."* Our soul's conversion/sanctification relies on God's Word. The more I think God's Word, the more I walk in the liberty of the Holy Spirit. *"Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty."* God's commands are His Blessings! They guide our lives to His grace, goodness, and provision. *"Seek ye FIRST the kingdom of God and His righteousness (obey Truth) and ALL these THINGS shall be added unto you."* I dare you to put this promise to the test!
