We're oh, so very sensitive about what other's THINK, but give little or no thought to what God KNOWS! Men will have no say in YOUR eternal destiny; God Predetermined every consequence from Eternity Past and your destiny is based on your own choices. God Foreknew every thought! "Without faith it is IMPOSSIBLE to please Him." Faith "is the GIFT of God" given to those who receive, believe, and obey God's Word. Those who disdain or ignore it seal their own destiny.
