


*“Give unto the LORD the Glory due unto His Name; Worship The LORD In The Beauty Of Holiness.” Psalm 29:2 KJV*



We must *“Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise.”* There is no higher praise than loving, trusting, and obeying God. *“I have no greater Joy than to hear that my children walk in Truth.”* God is His Word and His Word is Holy! Obedience to God’s Word is worship. The cherubims around the Throne never cease to cry, *“Holy! Holy! Holy!”*

Holiness is the perfection of righteousness: No comeliness, no error, no flaw, and no wrong for God is *“altogether Lovely!”* We consider some persons beautiful, pleasing to the eye, but even they do not bear close scrutiny. The most beautiful models, male or female, wear makeup to hide flaws. Diamonds touted as flawless still have minute fissures in them; the fewest perhaps, but have them, nonetheless. Holiness begins in thought. If we think right, we will do right. *“Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly. Thou shalt meditate therein day and night.”* God’s Holiness is Light. Where Holiness is, unholiness disappears. It is viral. What it touches becomes Holy. The woman with the issue of blood was healed when she touched the hem of Jesus’ garment. Satan wants us to believe that darkness has a greater power than light, but where light is, darkness vaporizes. Cigarettes were forbidden outside at night in WWI and WWII, because the glow of an ember can be seen from 10,000 feet; the darker the night, the brighter the candle. When London was being bombed by the Nazis, the tiniest sliver of light from a house was illegal at night. Light pierces darkness like a sword. When we obey God, we enter into the Pure Light of Holiness. Laser is but one focused spectrum of red light that can drill a precise hole in titanium in seconds. If only one spectrum of light is that powerful, how powerful is the presence of Him who *is* Light? *“God is Light, and in Him is no darkness at all.”* This is why no man can see God and live! God had to wrap Himself in a cloud, and put Moses in a cleft of a rock as He passed by. We must be changed physically to be like Him. Human flesh would simply vaporize in His Light! Believers will have new bodies, like Jesus, so we may stand unharmed in His presence. *“Behold, I shew you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed: In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: For the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. We know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.”* For now, we worship, through the power of faith and prayer. *“For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face.”* We enter into the parallel dimension of The God of Light by faith; and by prayer, the presence of the Holy Spirit as we intimately commune with the KING of Kings! Through His Word He speaks to us in our hearts and minds throughout each day as we worship through meditation and obedience.
