

*"Call unto Me, and **I Will Answer Thee, And Show Thee Great And Mighty Things**, which thou knowest not." Jeremiah 33:3 KJV*

God cannot lie! Because His Word Is So Powerful When He Speaks, It Is So! "With God, nothing shall be impossible." His promises are more secure than sunrise! (He created sunrise.) "The heavens declare the glory of God!" If you have not witnessed God's great and mighty power, then you have not truly looked at creation or called on Him. Either you trust God implicitly or you disbelieve. If there's something God said that you disbelieve or are afraid to test, you are an unbeliever! Many claim God doesn't answer their prayers. "Ye have not because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. Ye adulterers and adulteresses know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God." Always remember, "No" is an answer. Make sure through careful study that what you desire is in line with God's Word, and then ask for it. Don't stop. "And this is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His Will, He Heareth us: What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them." God will not force men to do things, but He can certainly make them willing. He sent hornets to make the Canaanites "willing" to leave. God will not compel you to go 'gainst your will, but He'll sure make you willin' to go! "Delight thyself also in the Lord; and He Shall Give thee (change) the desires of thine heart. If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, That Giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and It Shall Be Given him. But let him ask in Faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. For let not that man think that he shall receive any thing of the Lord." Don't try to trust God with your feelings or flesh. "For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For I know that...in my flesh dwelleth no good thing: Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the Law of God, neither indeed can be." Your fleshly desires/feelings are unable to perceive God or His Power. Faith and Love must complete the senses and allow perception of both the spiritual and physical dimensions. Faith and Love go beyond the body into the Presence of God. "Now Faith Is the Substance of things Hoped for, the Evidence of things not seen. Without Faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He Is, and that He Is A Rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Whatsoever is not of Faith is sin." When feelings and doubt assail your Faith, pray with the grieving father, "Lord I believe! Help Thou mine unbelief!" God "Knoweth our frame; He Remembereth that we are dust [and] the Mercy of the LORD Is from Everlasting to Everlasting upon them that fear Him." God's Spirit is Omnipresent in space AND time. He Can Turn past events to your benefit. "ALL things work together FOR GOOD to them that love God, to them who are the called according to HIS PURPOSE. If I ascend up into Heaven, Thou Art There: if I make my bed in Hell, behold, Thou Art There." There is no place or time God cannot hear or help you!
