

*"And Miriam and Aaron spake against Moses because of the Ethiopian woman whom he had married: for he had married an Ethiopian woman. And they said, 'Hath the LORD indeed spoken only by Moses? Hath he not spoken also by us?' And **The LORD Heard It.**" Numbers 12:1-2 KJV*



Beware negativity concerning those or their family that God Has Called to be the spiritual leaders in the Assembly. If you sincerely believe they teach heresy, privately, after much prayer and Bible study concerning the issue, ask them humbly to explain it. If, after private discussion with them and consultation with your pastor, it remains unresolved, QUIETLY find another Bible governed and Holy Spirit led Assembly in which to serve. Intentional disruption of any God ordained Assembly is the act of “sowing discord among the Brethren” and an “abomination” to God. “A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth. He winketh with his eyes, he speaketh with his feet, he teacheth with his fingers; These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaketh lies, and HE THAT SOWETH DISCORD among brethren.” The first six things God hates, but the last seven are an “abomination” to Him. An “abomination,” is something that makes you want to puke! The LORD Will Hear malicious tongues and Recompense the impertinent severely! If a leader is truly called of God, you put yourself in grave danger speaking about them in a negative or gossipy manner. You have presumed yourself their equal. Lucifer attempted this: “I will be like the Most High” to which God Responded, “Thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.” The only one instructed to rebuke anyone publicly in the Assembly is the pastor and then only in proven instances. “Against an elder receive not an accusation, but before two or three witnesses. Them that sin rebuke before all, that others also may fear.” The lesson is clear: Don’t murmur, complain, or gossip against leaders in the Assembly! God WILL Handle His Own! You will smart for it and may even die if not interceded for by the injured party. Miriam thought herself Moses’ equal as his older sister, but God struck her with leprosy, because she questioned Moses’ authority. Moses had to plead with the LORD, “Heal her now, O God, I beseech Thee.” Even healed “Miriam was shut out from the camp seven days.” Your sin hinders the whole Assembly. “The people journeyed not till Miriam was brought in again.” Unless you repent, you may be left behind to rot in your sin. Irreverence about leaders God choses removes you from the Assembly’s protection! Miriam was alone in the wilderness! God Will Remove His Chosen, Himself! God told Moses, “SPEAK ye unto the rock before their eyes; and it shall give forth his water. Moses... SMOTE the rock twice.” God then said, “Because ye believed Me not...ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I Have Given them.” The rock which gave water was symbolic of the Lord Jesus Who Was only Smitten once by God.
