


"The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer."
Psalm 6:9 KJV

What loving father ignores his pleading child? God always hears the believer's cry. *"This is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing ACCORDING TO HIS WILL, He heareth us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."* Know God's Word and know for what to ask. The cry of a rebellious heart falls on deaf ears! *"If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me."* You can't be righteously rebellious against God for *"rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft."* Whatever the reason, resisting God's Word is rebellion. Satan has many convenient lies for self-delusion, like, "I just can't do it, I'm too weak," or "It's just not me!" All of which are true if we obey our own desire (lusts) over God's Word. *"For in my flesh dwelleth no good thing."* But it is our weakness that showcases God's power! God says, *"My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness."* Trust and obey and you'll find your way! We often fall prey to lust, but we need only humbly confess and plead for help to be forgiven and cleansed. *"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us of ALL unrighteousness. For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity... 'I dwell in the High and Holy Place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart.'*" We no longer need blood sacrifices for the remission of sin, because *"Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation. By Him, therefore, let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name. If any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: And He is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world."* Anyone mired in sin need only call upon the name of the Saviour. *"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord, shall be saved! Thou shalt call his name JESUS: for He shall save his people from their sins."* If you are a true believer, you are *"His people,"* and His grace is *"sufficient for you!"* "Jesus Saves" is present tense! He will save you as often as you cry to Him!
