The fear of man bringeth a snare. Fear Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom.”* The first fear is foolish and damning, the second, prudent and saving. It is prudent and saving to fear the chasm. You can fear men or you can fear God. Decision determines destiny and choice determines consequence. You can choose to face death fearlessly or fearfully.
