

*"And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, 'Thou art Christ the Son of God!' And He rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for they knew that He was Christ." Luke 4:41 KJV*



Who Is Jesus – to you? The devils know who He is and are afraid of Him! Notice “Son” in our text is capitalized. In Luke 1:38 it says, “...which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God;” “son” is lower case. Paul explains: “The First man, Adam, was made a living soul; the Last Adam (Jesus) was made a quickening spirit.” Adam’s body came from the dust, fully grown. Christ’s body was heavenly created by spoken Word of God and placed in Mary, the virgin’s, womb as a fertilized egg cell where it grew and was born. “And the angel came in unto [Mary], and said, ‘Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.’” God’s Word says, “God is a spirit.” The simplest meaning of the name “Adam” is “flesh and blood human being.” (See Strong’s H119-H121) God’s Word also says, “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. – And the Word WAS MADE FLESH, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and Truth.” Mary was not sinless. Her own lips acknowledged Christ as “My Saviour,” but what she bore was Holy and sinless. God created a human body which He inhabited and walked among men. AMONG men. In Eden God walked WITH man. His disciples, came to know Him and walked with Him as far as it was humanly possible to do, but even they faltered at the hour of Redemption. God withdrew His presence from the Cross when all the sin of man was borne there, in His own body, prompting midday darkness and the cry, “My God! My God! Why hast Thou forsaken me?” God knew every human pang of torture, from birth to Crucifixion, which is why “we have not an High Priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.” He even refused the offering of drink. He did not curse His tormenters, but instead cried, “Father forgive them; they know not what they do!” In His own Body, God experienced every temptation of man! You know it takes an impure thought to bring temptation to sin. “God cannot be tempted with evil, (no impure thoughts) neither tempteth He any man: But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, (impure thoughts) and enticed. Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.” Christ never even had an impure thought, because His mind was and is The Word of God! “Let THIS MIND be in you which was also in Christ Jesus.”

Like God, men may choose what to do, but cannot know sinlessness. Only those who obey God’s Word may walk “with” God. The “last Adam” restores, through faith, the relationship of Eden.
