

"Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof." Romans 6:12 KJV

The Apostle's use of the word *ōletō* indicates that the believer's *ōnew creatureō* in Christ has the power to control the sinful lusts of the flesh. God's Word confirms it. *ōAs many as received Him, to them gave He Power. I can do ALL things through Christ.ō* If I sin, it's because I've allowed a fleshly lust and not kept my body under subjection. *ōKnow ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether*



of sin unto death (lust), or of obedience (Truth) unto righteousness?ō It is not an, *ōI CAN'T* help it, *ō* situation. It is an, *ōI DIDN'T* help it, *ō* situation. Strength to combat the wickedness of the flesh is gathered from our thoughts of God and His Word. *ōThis Book of The Law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate (think) therein day and night. Let this mind be in you.ō* When we start realizing we stand forgiven and the sin *ōwhich doth so easily beset usō* only needs to be confessed and forsaken; we can experience the liberty of *ōwalking in the Spirit!ō* We were forgiven at Calvary. Our fleshly desires are the chains that keep us from the Joy of walking in the Blessed Light of Truth. *ōThe Joy of the Lord is your strength.ō* It can only be maintained by daily reading and meditation with the KING of Heaven. Don't save sin up for a *ōtime of confession.ō* You'll forget. Confess sin and stop it immediately when the Lord convicts you. It is a rock in your shoe. Sin is a *ōsoul leechō* and must be instantly plucked away before it saps life from us and injects numbing doubt and despair. The Joy of the Lord is the Life energy needed to continue without becoming *ōweary in well doing.ō* As long as we confess sin instantly, we remain in the Holy Light of the Eternal God. The time to confess a sin is as soon as the Holy Spirit convinces you of it. *ōPray without ceasingō* is a Holy invitation to walk with the KING. If there is a distance between you and God, it is your doing not His. *ōDraw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you.ō* You have everything you need to walk a consecrated path. Don't believe Satan's whispers of *ōYou can't do it!ō* or *ōit's just too hard!ō* That is a lie! God's Word says different. *ōI can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.ō* Do you believe God or not? God will not force our choice, but He will empower our faithful obedience. Faith is not what you claim to believe; it is what you do. *ōFaith, if it hath not works, is dead.ō* Is your faith dead?
