For as the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither...so shall my Word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it."* God's Word is so powerful it created existence from nothing, and brings to naught what is!
