

"And so it is written, 'The first man Adam was made a living soul; the LAST Adam was made a quickening Spirit.' **1 Corinthians 15:45No2 KJV**

The first Adam was Life breathed into flesh; the "last Adam" was Life made flesh. "*In the beginning was the WORD, and the WORD was with God, and THE WORD WAS GOD. And the WORD was MADE FLESH, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and Truth. Jesus saith unto him, 'I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. Sanctify them through Thy Truth: Thy WORD is Truth.'*" Jesus is God, the Word, the Truth, and came that men might have Life "*and that they might have it more abundantly.*" Life will be eternally abundant when this robe of flesh drops away and replaced with a spiritual body. Men exist in a physical dimension, not spiritual. Parallel dimensions are reality. Can you see oxygen? Can you exist without it? Isn't "Out of sight out of mind?" The unseen doesn't occupy much conscience thought. If it can't be sensed, men assume it doesn't exist. The spiritual dimension perceives and moves freely about in the physical dimension. Fallen angels/demons/evil spirits molest, oppress, and possess men. God's Holy Spirit also indwells men. The difference is; God's Spirit brings God's Life and power; that is, quickens the spirit of a man; evil counterfeits life by empowering the flesh of a man through faith in His Word. God's Spirit transforms natural to supernatural. Evil titillates and enslaves the flesh with sin. "*When lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death, but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.*" The Holy Spirit transforms the physical by quickening (making alive) the spirit of a man. "*If the Spirit of Him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, He that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by His Spirit that dwelleth in you.*" Eternal Life in perfect bodies awaits every believer. When the Son rises on eternity's dawn, the saints of every age will move into the spiritual dimension forever in a new body just like the one God has chosen for Himself which is Jesus. "*Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when [Jesus] shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as He is.*" (See Rev. 1:12-18) If there's no God, there's no Satan. Satan can't pretend to be God if he's recognized. See how clever he is! You can't prove God exists with a test tube! Men who refuse to believe in the supernatural God are doomed to "believe a lie." The miracle of the "Last Adam" proves what the angel said to Mary, "*With God, nothing shall be impossible.*"

Faith in God really is a "Life or Death" decision. Don't make the fatal mistake of unbelief.
