

“While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.” 2 Corinthians 4:18^{no4} KJV



What are you looking at? The electron microscope views molecular structure and the Hubble telescope views distant galactic structures.
