God's Word can only be heard by lost men from the lips of the believer. "How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!' But they have not all obeyed the Gospel. For Esaias saith, 'Lord, who hath believed our report?' So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God." Jesus said, "And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me." Oil must be in constant supply, so our lamps continue to burn brightly. "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." God's Word is the "mind of Christ" the same as your word is your mind. You must think it before you speak it. If trash is on your lips, trash is in your mind! We clean our minds through study of and meditation on God's Word. Jesus said, "Now ye are clean through the Word which I have spoken unto you."
