If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, 'Remove hence to yonder place;' and it shall remove; and NOTHING SHALL BE IMPOSSIBLE unto you."* Obedience and faith are directly proportional. If you believe little, you obey little. Lack of obedience is unbelief. It lets us sink in the sea of circumstance. *"The god of this world (Satan) hath blinded the minds of them which BELIEVE NOT."* If you want to understand God, you MUST believe and obey His Word! There is no alternative. Even disobedient believers will lack discernment and provision. The wonderful Savior is always waiting with outstretched hand to pluck us immediately from the sea of doubt if we but cry, *"Lord, save me!"* He IS our Saviour, not WAS our Saviour. Peace is knowing that *"if God be for us, who can be against us?"* Joy is anticipating God's promises and enjoying God. Consciousness is what you think and what you think will dictate your actions. The more God's Word dwells in your consciousness, the less room there is for the weeds of doubt and the more abundant Life will be. You cannot add anything to a full vessel.
