

"Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath: Neither give place to the devil." Ephesians 4:26-27 KJV

How much cancer is OK? Sin is sin, no matter how little a matter you may judge it. How much cyanide would be OK? Sin is deadly to the sinner, because God will depart from it and the sinner, and there is no life without God! *"The WAGES of sin is death."* God will not tolerate sin, but He will forgive sin, because He already paid your penalty and because He loves you. Obeying the lust of the flesh was the original cause of man's separation from God and it will still draw you into sin and separation unless you obey God out of faith and love. It's the only way. There are not many roads to heaven. You don't worship God in your own way; you do it His way. *"God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in Truth."* Your own way is not worship; it's rebellion; and *"rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft."* Those who "worship" God in their own way, on Judgment Day will hear, *"Depart from me! I never knew you!"* It's God's way or there's Hell to pay! You don't get on the airplane your own way. You must board like anyone else using the accepted method the airline imposes. Cornelius Stam got it right when He said, "There are too many Evangelists and preachers offering a "Try Me" God. – Not happy? Try God. Life in a mess? Try God." The Truth is; do it God's way or die eternal death! *"God is angry with the wicked EVERY DAY! But the fearful, and UNBELIEVING, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and ALL LIARS, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the Second Death."* Unbelief is wickedness, because you are calling the "God which CANNOT lie" a liar! God hates sin, because all sin begins in unbelief! His wrath against it is infinite! Sin fills up His cup of wrath against you. Those who unrepentantly revel and bask in sin's self indulgence are wicked. *"Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath."* For that very reason, we can equate sin directly with God's wrath. Don't let "God's Wrath" accumulate on your head. Immediately turn from sin when told of it by God's Word. *"Let not the sun go down upon your wrath."* Anger is the quickest path to sin. It is one of the most powerful emotions of the flesh and unless we're very alert, it will pull us into *"the wrath of God. Be ye angry and sin not."* Isn't it usually a family member who most quickly irritates us? The same is true in the House of God. Believers are who we are usually angry with most readily.
