

*"For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto His glorious body, according to the working whereby He is able even to subdue all things unto Himself." **Philippians 3:20-21 KJV***



No prophecy needs yet unfold before Christ returns. All is ready. For this they WILLINGLY are ignorant of, that by the Word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same Word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the Day of Judgment and perdition of ungodly men."* (see also 2 Timothy 3:1-7) We are told *"watch and wait."* Are your affairs in order? Are you and your family ready? Many perished in the flood-waters of an impossible rain, and many more will perish in the Fire of an impossible pit! Jesus said He would rise and He did! Jesus said, *"Behold, I come quickly,"* and He will, soon!
